We had an insightful presentation by Ballard's marketing manager, Catherine Reid on their products and the future of fuel cells in the clean energy sector. Specifically, Ballard expects growth in fuel cell adoption by heavy-duty motive OEMs (long-distance buses and trucks) and welcomes the new challenges in product development for this field. This was followed by an interesting tour of their test lab which showcased their products currently in use for buses in California, Europe, and China.
